- 1. Next Board Meetings:

- 3. Roster: Heidi will send an updated roster soon.
- 4. Treasurer's Report (Heidi)
 - a. Financial Update: Two more deposits left from registration (not represented here). Operations: \$20,669.57. Gaming: \$848.74. General Savings: \$20,518.45.
 - b. Tax Update: DONE.
 - c. Gaming Permit: Heidi and Lisa are currently on record, so we need to get Kelda certified. Kelda and Heidi will serve as our certified officials. Due date: 12/15/16.
 - d. Developing a budget: The Board needs to do this in conjunction with a strategic plan for the next 1.5 years. Lori will send an email about this.

5. Old Business:

- a. Debrief Family Potluck: Overall, it went well. Timing was perfect to welcome new families with returning families.
- b. Equipment needs (Luke/Connor): freestyle ropes are ordered in spools and don't appear to have arrived yet. Trish Dihle and Erin Dean have signed up to help with equipment and uniforms and they could do a uniform inventory and get jumpers set for this year.
- c. Mirror Update (Heidi): GV has two mirrors they are willing to give us. We need frames built for the mirrors and the mirrors need to be covered in plexiglass. Once the mirrors are built into the frames, we can deliver them to the school for mounting by school facilities staff. Kelda thinks her husband can build the frame. She'll coordinate with GV to get the mirrors home.
- d. T-shirt Design (Lori): t-shirt color preference: Glacier Blue with white print. Discussion about the tank tops not all the kids feel comfortable in the tank tops and they stood out. They practice and perform locally in t-shirts. Discussion about a quick dry format. Discuss uniforms later. Yes, the logo on the shirt.
